- Engage in research and scholarly activities in higher education teaching and learning, technology-enhanced learning, and assessment practices, contributing to publications, conferences, and institutional research outputs.
- Provide academic support, supervision, and mentorship to students, including postgraduate supervision where applicable, and contribute to student academic development and retention.
- Participate in academic administration, programme accreditation, quality assurance processes, and institutional committees related to teaching and learning.
- Maintain active involvement in continuous professional development related to higher education pedagogy, digital education, and assessment innovation.
